Registration is limited and will be on a first come, first served basis. * Registrations received online fewer than 14 days before the event takes place will incur a late charge of \$10.

¹ **Membership:** When you register on our website (www.flenj.org), your membership status will be verified to allow you access to the membership pricing. Purchase Orders: If paying the regular registration rate by purchase order, the purchase order must be received by FLENJ no later than 21 days before the event, or your registration will be canceled and you will be waitlisted. If paying the late registration rate, the purchase order must be received by FLENJ no later than 7 days before the event, or your registration will be canceled.
